However, meeting the **requirements** like:

- **German language** proficiency level **B1**
- having **qualifications** that align with the job market demand
- **last 2-3 years working experience** in the **relevant niche**

is **crucial** for successful employment.

The minimum level B1 is usually required for
basic communication

Higher proficiency, B2 or C1, might be
necessary for **more specialized roles or**
deeper integration into the workplace and
society.

- **Make sure your social media profile is always up to date as a lot of employers in Germany use LinkedIn, Xing or freelancer.de to recruit talents.**
- **Update your CV in English and German!**
- **Subscribe to newsletters** with relevant job openings and **keep applying** for jobs via www.stepstone.de, freelancer.de etc.
- **Submit the applications** in the language of the job posting- **in German!!!**
- **Keep learning German with language specialists** that help you with your profile, cover letter, job interview, documents and... your confidence. 😊
- **Be prepared for the initial call** with recruiters, HR and employers.
- **Find out about your country`s visa/ language requirements** and other details to work in Germany

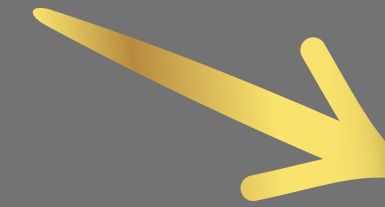
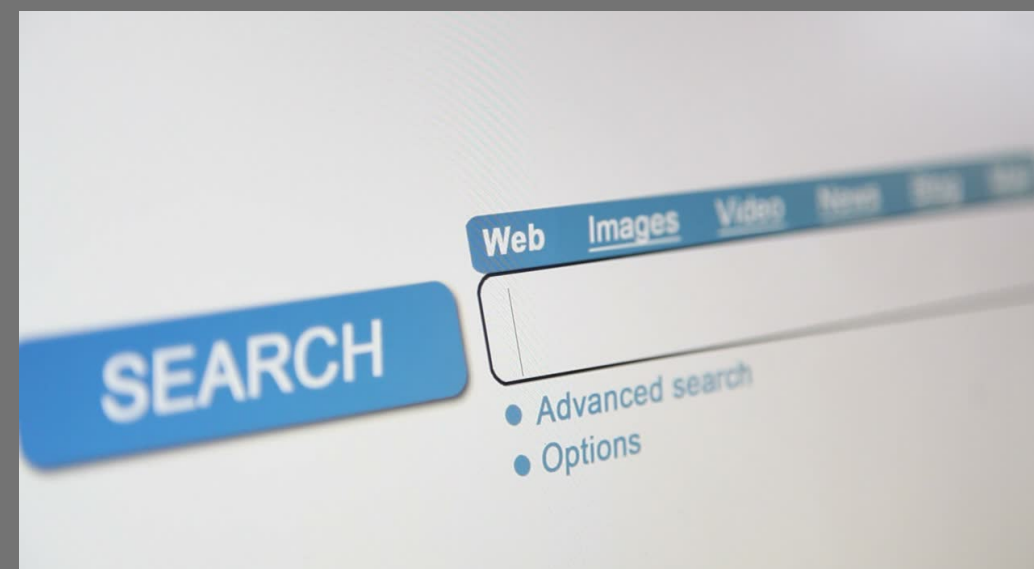
